SUBJECT: Aircrew Training of Weaponsers.

TO: Commanding General, Army Air Forces, Washington 25, D. C.  
(Attention: Colonel John G. Armstrong, Spec. Asst. AC/AS-3).

1. Reference is made to your letter, above subject, dated 27 November 1946.
